



# Need Medical Help?

## Minor Injuries Units

- ★ Provide treatment for a range of conditions, including burns, cuts, sprains, strains, minor head injuries and wounds requiring stitching. You can also get treatment for minor illnesses such as migraines, haemorrhoids, eczema, rashes, ear infections, tonsillitis and emergency contraception. Most can also treat simple breaks and fractures, but only during x-ray opening times (listed below)

## Urgent Care Centres

- ★ Provide treatment for minor and moderate injuries, such as burns and scalds, fractures to legs, arms, ankles and wrists and lacerations that require stitching. They can carry out X-rays and initiate treatment for more serious injuries. X-ray opening times are often limited and treatment of fractures will not be possible outside of these times (listed below).
